PICK A PATHWAY FOR YOUR CORE EXPERIENCE

- Community Service**
300 hours of community service from at least 2 organizations
- Diversity & Social Advocacy**
200 hours of immersion in, or service to, a community that experiences societal challenges, documented through community service, internship, peer leadership **and** a 30-hour research or advocacy project related to the population or issue you proposed for your 200 hours of service, internship, or peer leadership.
- Global Learning**
One of the following:
 - 12 weeks of study abroad
 - 8 weeks of faculty-led study abroad
 - 6 weeks of faculty-led study abroad and a minimum of 60 hours of focused local international experiences.
- Professional & Civic Engagement**
Part A: 60 hours leadership experience (including paid leadership positions)
Part B: One of the following:
 - 240 hours of internship/practicum/work experience
 - 120 hours work/professional experience and 1 additional semester in a leadership role that is a different experience than the one used to fulfill Part A.
- Research**
Participant in a research or discovery project for a minimum of 2 semesters

PARTICIPATE IN ENHANCEMENT ACTIVITIES

Enhancement activities are experiences you engage in beyond the classroom that help you develop an understanding of your pathway. They can be a one-time event that requires passive attendance or ongoing activities that require active participation. Examples include but are not limited to workshops, guest lectures, conferences/presentations, official meetings, job shadowing, and out-of-class events/trips. It is up to you to articulate how your activity is related to your pathway. **Note:** Attendance records or verification is **not required** for submitting enhancement activities.
