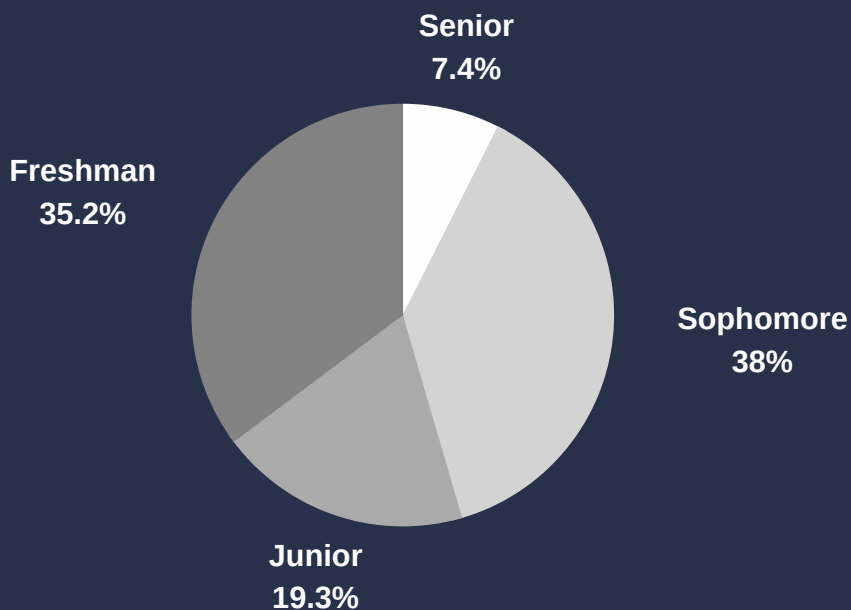

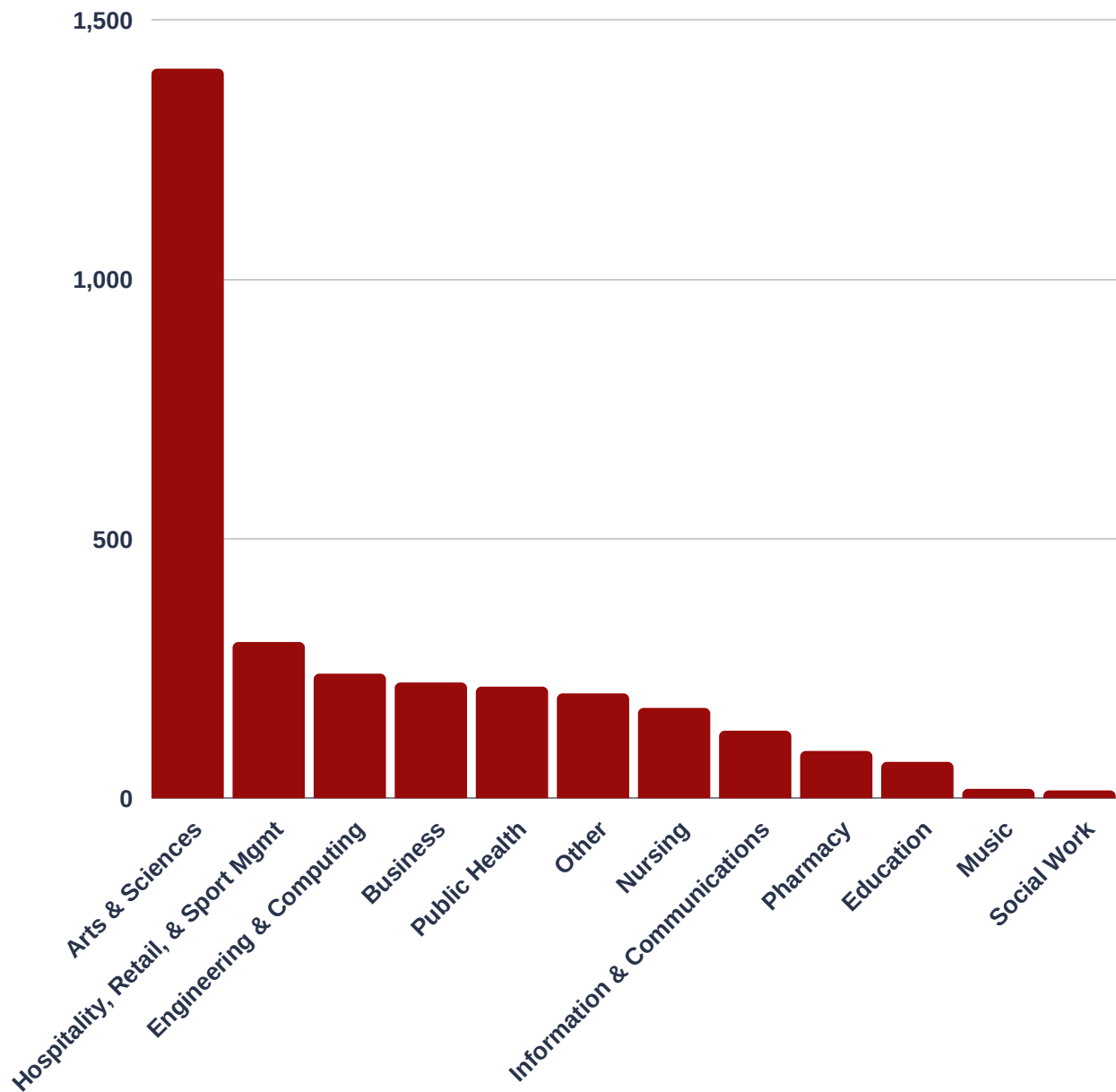

Year in Review

WHO VISITS EXPLORATORY ADVISING?

Not every student who visits Exploratory Advising changes their major, but all students who visit our office learn about major programs at UofSC, major change requirements and processes, and how their existing credits may apply to other majors.

Over 3,000 students visited Exploratory Advising in the 2019-2020 academic year. The graph above shows the college or school that students were currently enrolled in when they visited the Exploratory Advising Office. The proportion of students from each college or school who visited Exploratory Advising closely mirrors the relative size, both in student population and majors offered, of those colleges and schools. Thus, 46% of students who visited Exploratory Advising were enrolled in the College of Arts and Sciences—the largest college at UofSC, home to over half of majors offered and one third of the student population.
