Graduation of Transfer Students 2010-2011

In a given year, transfer students represent what % of degrees conferred?

Transfer students make up approximately 25% of degrees conferred in a given year. For Spring/Summer 2013, 23.8% of graduates (1,269) were transfer students.

For the question above, a Transfer Student = a student who has completed 25 or more credit hours at another institution.

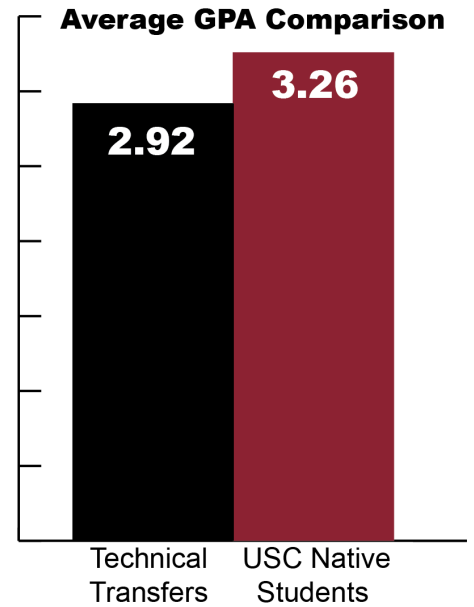

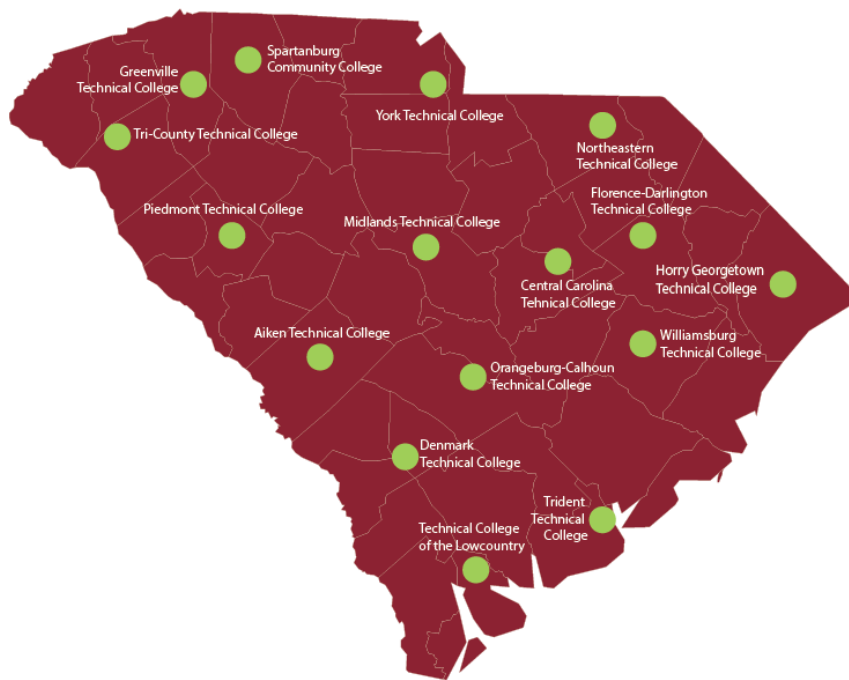

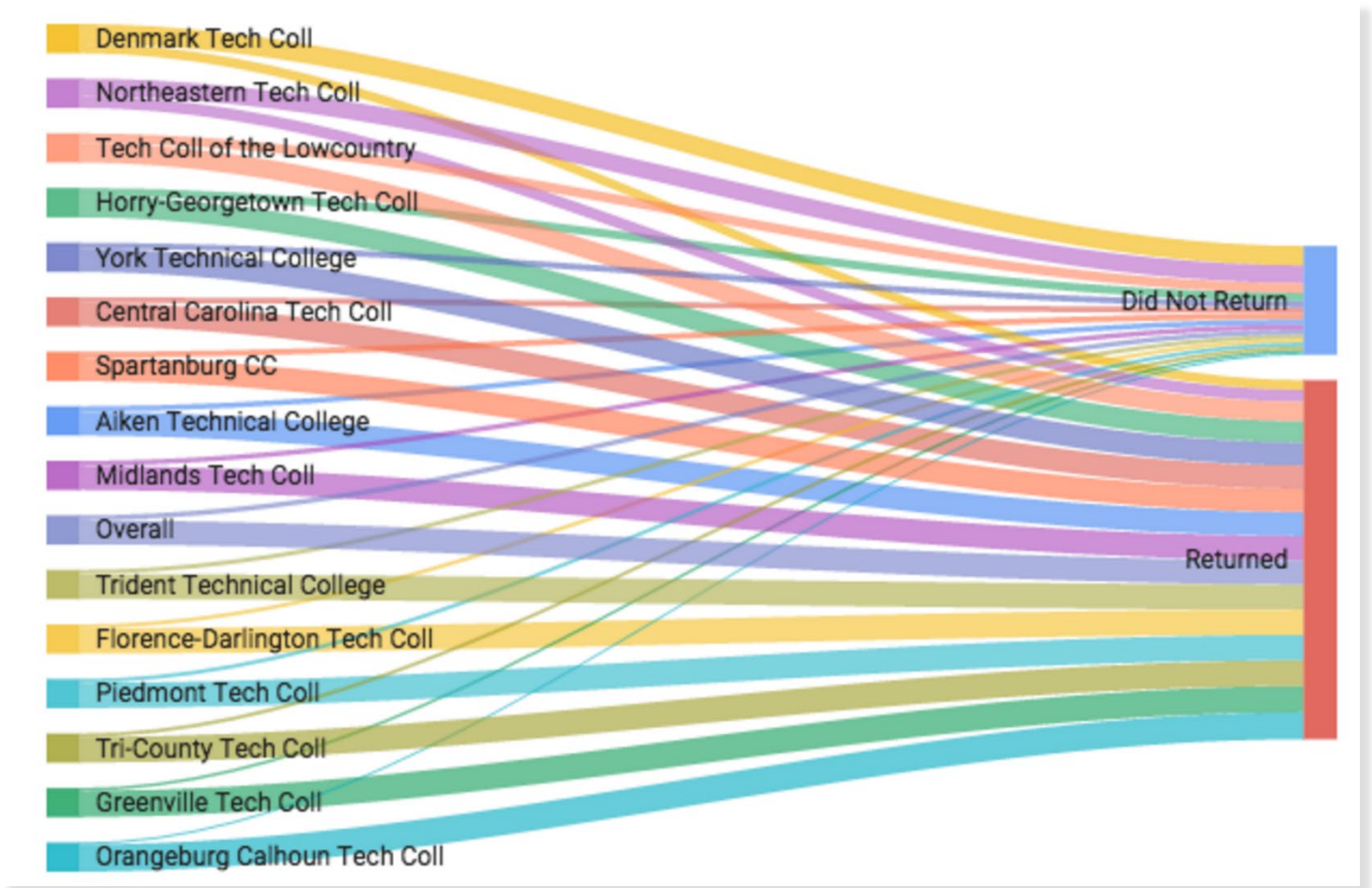

Transfer Students rate of return from first year to second per technical college.



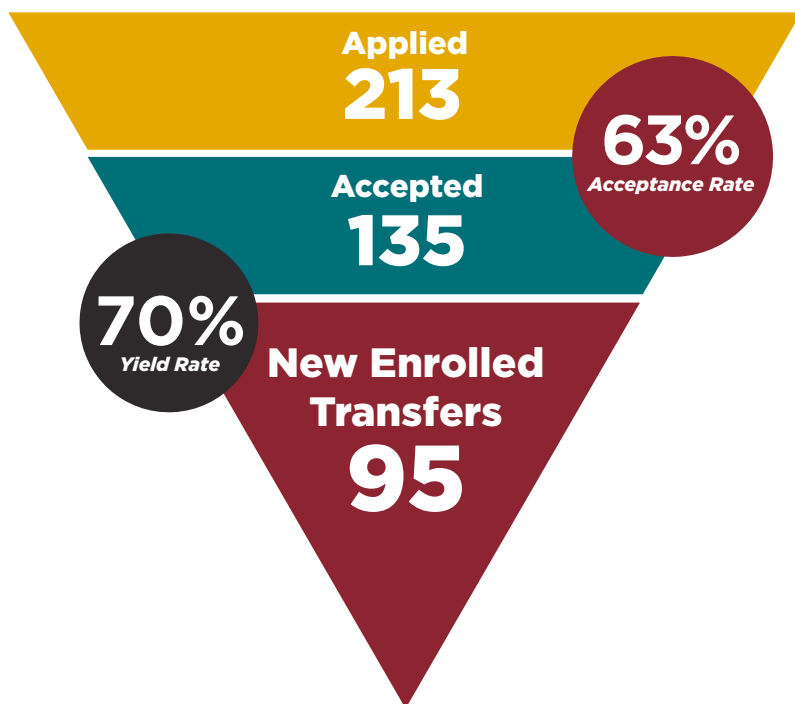
