## Compliance

The Off-Site Reaffirmation Committee found support for the institution's case for compliance.

The institution maintains published admissions policies for its various campuses, degree levels, colleges, and academic programs. Senior administrators, under the direction and support of the admissions committee, guide undergraduate admission decisions. A similar framework is used for graduate and professional school admission decisions. The university partners with agents for international student recruitment with pre-established institutional admissions criteria to ensure students are academically prepared. The admissions staff, along with the Office of Communications and Public Affairs and other selected departmental representatives, annually review and produce recruitment material. The admissions staff have procedures in place to manage accurate online and campus presentations. Two or three rounds of material reviewed by multiple people occurs to ensure accuracy of recruitment materials. The institution provided policies, admissions publication, and videos, along with example committee reports.
