Narrative

Accountability and commitment to continuous leadership improvement are critical to the University of South Carolina Columbia and regional Palmetto College campuses' success. The Board of Trustees has an obligation to deliver the very best leadership possible to ensure that the University of South Carolina Columbia and regional Palmetto College campuses successfully achieves their mission and vision. To accomplish this, the Board of Trustees has developed a process for self-evaluation. The instrument was first administered during the summer of 2018. The focus is on improving Board performance and the services it provides in advancing the University of South Carolina Columbia.

Board Duties and Responsibilities

The final authority and responsibility for the governance of the University of South Carolina is vested in its Board of Trustees ("Board") in accordance with the statutes of the State of South Carolina. Sections 59-101-185 and 59-117-40 of the South Carolina Code of Laws as well as the Board of Trustees Bylaws and Board Policy BTRU 1.00 Statutory Basis of the University clearly delineate the powers and responsibilities of the University of South Carolina Board of Trustees. Standards 4.1a-e provides additional details regarding Board characteristics and responsibilities.

Board Self-Evaluation Instrument

The Board's Self-Assessment includes an examination of three (3) broad areas: (a) board meetings, (b) board performance and service, and (c) strategic planning and annual processes. The instrument has, 25 questions, using a 3-point Likert scale responses (i.e., agree, needs improvement, disagree, and no response). The University has provided copies of the self-evaluation for 2018 and 2019.


