Please be aware that, starting January 2021, the institution must have their first two new off-campus instructional sites approved by extensive review. Institutions on substantive change restriction must have all off-campus instructional sites approved by extensive review. Prior to the off-campus instructional site reaching the 50% threshold for a program, a prospectus for approval by extensive review must be submitted for review at the next regularly scheduled SACSCOC Board of Trustees meeting. The deadlines are:

- March 15 for the June meeting
- September 1 for the December meeting

If the institution has been approved for at least two off-campus instructional sites by extensive review, is not on substantive change restriction, a prospectus for approval by limited review should be submitted **prior** to reaching the 50% threshold. As a reminder, the 50% threshold requiring approval applies to any program offered by the institution, i.e., certificate, diploma, and degree programs. The due dates for submission of a prospectus are:

- January 1 for sites reaching the 50% threshold between July 1 and December 31 of the current year, *or*
- July 1 for sites reaching the 50% threshold between January 1 and June 30 of the following year.
