The University of South Carolina – Columbia plans to implement a dual academic award agreement between the Darla Moore School of Business and the Universidad Adolfo Ibanez Business School in Santiago, Chile, to offer the Ph.D. in Business Administration and the Ph.D. in Business Administration.

The awards offered will be graduate degrees. The agreement maintains compliance with SACSCOC Standard 9.5 to ensure that one-third of the credit hours earned through instruction is offered by the institution awarding the degree. The research will be collaboratively supervised between the two institutions, and it will be expected that dissertation committees will consist of faculty from both institutions. When students have completed the requirements for each program, they will be awarded the Ph.D. in Business Administration from the University of South Carolina – Columbia and the Ph.D. in Business Administration from Universidad Adolfo Ibanez Business School.
